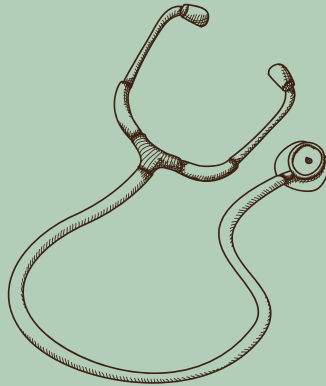

Helping the homeless is more than compassion; it's a commitment to building a kinder, inclusive world for everyone.



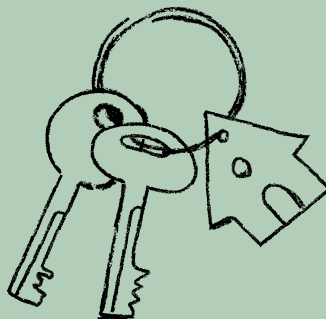

In 2021, we were able to start a city sanctioned campground to serve people experience houselessness. We work in collaboration with Kabba Recovery to house and manage 29 8x8 shelters.

MACHKabba Gardens was able to celebrate their one year anniversary of being a campground!

- Over the course of the year 60 individuals were able to stay at MACHKabba Gardens.
- 21 of those who stayed with us, exited into housing.

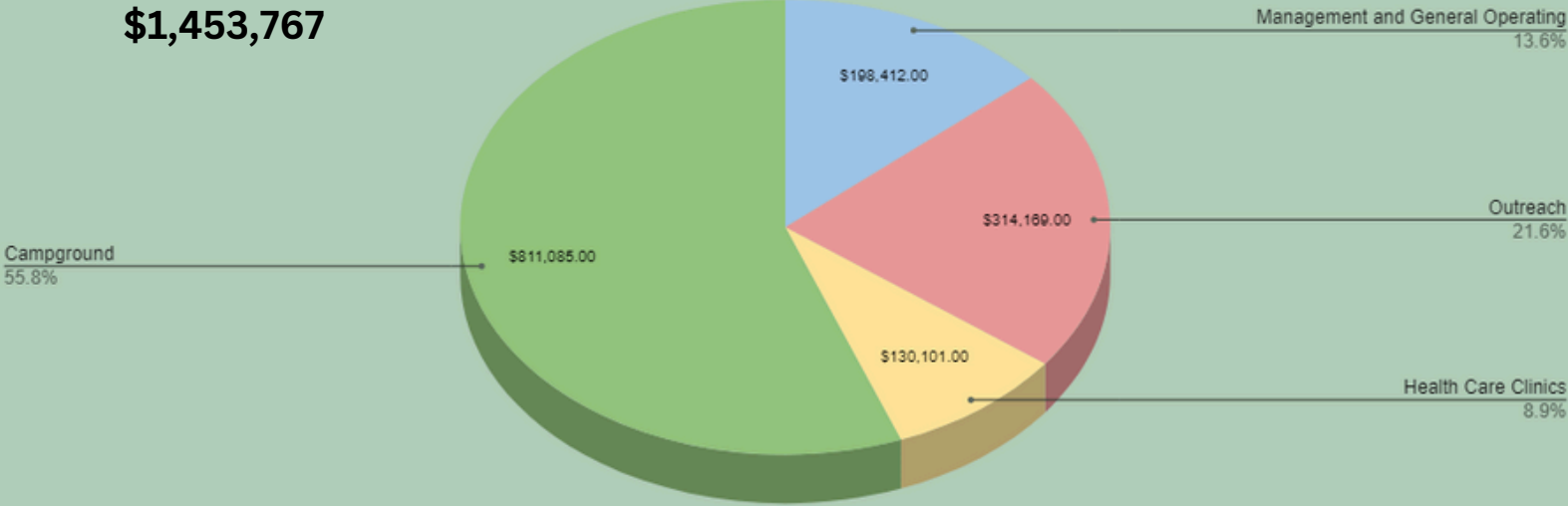

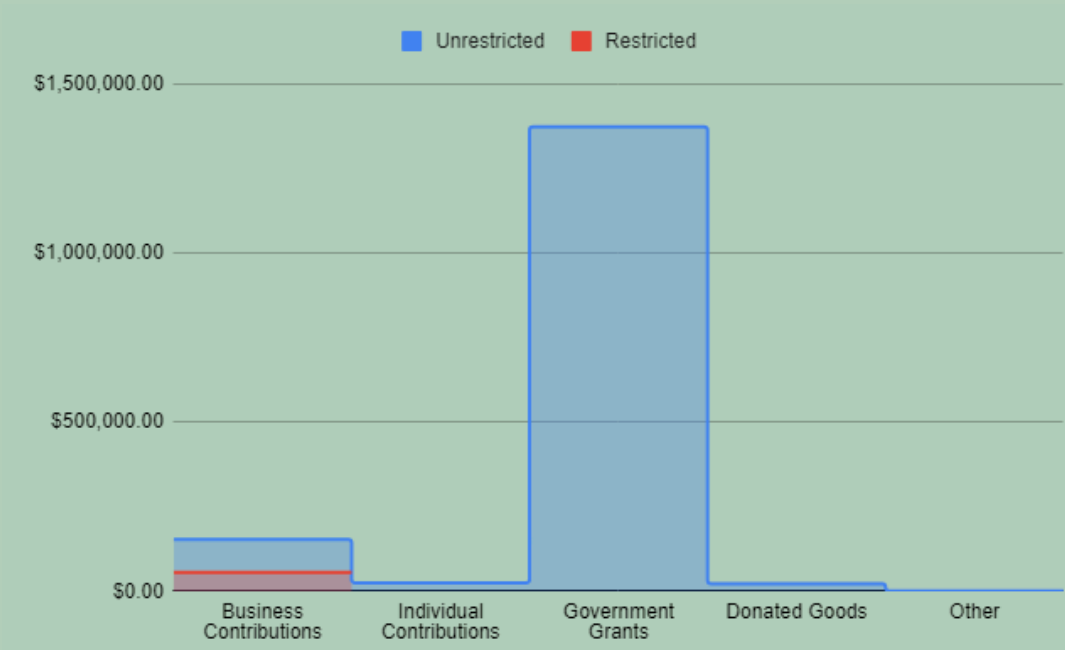
