

#### **MACHKABBA GARDENS**

In 2021, we were able to start a city sanctioned campground to serve people experience houselessness. We work in collaboration with Kabba Recovery to house and manage 29 8x8 shelters.

MACHKabba Gardens was able to celebrate their one year anniversary of being a campground!

- Over the course of the year 60 individuals were able to stay at MACHKabba Gardens.
- 21 of those who stayed with us, exited into housing.

### PANTRY

14,771 pounds of food have been donated to Second Harvest and provided to us to give out to our clients. This pantry began in August of 2022. Throughout the rest of the year in 2022, we saw over 600 people in the pantry.


